

TOWN OF LUNENBURG

BY-LAW NO. 41

CLOSING PUBLIC STREET

1. THAT the Council do close to public use a street or a portion of the said street known as Old Post Road.

2. THAT the street or portion thereof hereby closed to public use pursuant to Section 1 of this By-law is as follows:

ALL that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the Town of Lunenburg, in the County of Lunenburg in the Province of Nova Scotia, and being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

"That portion of the "Old Post Road" so-called beginning at a point on the northerly side line of the Main Highway leading to Bridgewater (now called Victoria Street) adjacent to property belonging to the estate of Ambrose Crouse.

THENCE in a North Easterly direction one thousand four hundred and seventy (1470) feet more or less to a point three hundred and sixty eight (368) feet more or less from the South Westerly side line of Green Street near Beck's Florist."

3. THAT the portion of Old Post Road as described in Section 2 of this By-law be closed and that all rights of public user heretofore as a street in the lands hereinbefore more particularly described are forever extinguished and the said Town may sell and convey the street or any portion thereof.
