

#31. TOWN OF LUNENBURG POLICY

OUT-OF-TOWN WATER SERVICE REQUESTS

I. Purpose:

As the Town's Water Utility (hereinafter referred to as "Utility") is considered by the Board of Public Utilities to be a separate entity and the Utility boundaries are greater than that of the Town, the supply of water by the Utility must equitably relate to all customers.

II. Procedure:

1. When water service requests are received by individuals living within the Utilities boundaries they will be dealt with as follows:

i) if the property requiring water service is located adjacent to a water main, the property will be serviced with all associated costs from the property line to the property (curb stop to property) being paid for by the customer; or

ii) if the property requiring water service requires a water main extension, the Lunenburg Town Council shall determine whether this extension should take place and the customer(s) to be serviced shall make a capital contribution based on the formula established by the Board of Public Utilities.

2. When water servicing requests are received from customers living outside present boundaries of the Water Utility the Town Council shall determine whether the extension should be granted.
