

#10. TOWN OF LUNENBURG

PRIVATE STREET AND YARD LIGHTS

1. The purpose of this policy is to outline the procedure which will be followed by the Electric Light Utility of the Town of Lunenburg when dealing with requests for Private Street and Yard Lights.
2. Private Street and Yard Lights
 - (1) If requested in writing to the Town Manager/Clerk by a Town of Lunenburg Electric Utility customer, the Town Electric Utility may provide and install a private street light on a Town utility pole connected to the Town's secondary and charge that customer the rate as approved by the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board from time to time (see: Schedule "A" attached).
 - (2) All Private Street and Yard Lights which presently exist and are connected to the Town's secondary will continue to be billed as in the past using the current street light rates as approved by the Nova Scotia Utility Review Board.
 - (3) All Private Street and Yard Lights which presently are on Town of Lunenburg's Utility poles with the Utilities permission and are wired directly to the customer's meter may continue to remain on these poles.
 - (4) Maintenance costs for all Private Street and Yard Lights which are wired to the customers meter will be the responsibility of the customers, whether they are on Town of Lunenburg's Electric Poles or not. However, only if requested, the Town Electric Utility forces will service those private street lights mounted on Town Electric Utility poles at the Electric Utility's regular charge out rates for parts, equipment and labor.
 - (5) Costs incurred by the Town for repairs and replacement of Town owned fixtures due to vandalism will be charged to the customer. Where a certain customer refuses to pay such costs, the Town may refuse to install a replacement fixture at that location.

3. Public Street Lights:

- (1) Any requests for public street lighting within the Town limits shall be in writing and forwarded to the Town Manager to be considered for approval by the Lunenburg Town Council.
- (2) Any requests for public street lighting outside the Town limits will not be considered unless the request comes through the Municipality of the District of Lunenburg ("Municipality"). Any public street lighting in the Municipality will be charged to the Municipality on a monthly basis in accordance with rates as approved by the Nova Scotia Utility Review Board.

Lunenburg Electric Utility

250 watt Mercury Vapour	\$158.54 per lamp per year
400 watt Mercury Vapour	\$223.86 per lamp per year

(High Pressure Sodium - Fixture supplied by the Utility)

A. (For fixtures replacing existing lighting only)

70 watt High Pressure Sodium	\$ 85.14 per lamp per year
100 watt High Pressure Sodium	\$ 94.44 per lamp per year
150 watt High Pressure Sodium	\$ 105.75 per lamp per year
200 watt High Pressure Sodium	\$ 120.09 per lamp per year

B. (For all new lighting)

70 watt High Pressure Sodium	\$ 95.24 per lamp per year
100 watt High Pressure Sodium	\$ 104.54 per lamp per year
150 watt High Pressure Sodium	\$ 115.85 per lamp per year
200 watt High Pressure Sodium	\$ 131.20 per lamp per year

Availability: The street lighting rate shall be applicable to the supply of outdoor illumination on a dusk-to-dawn schedule involving approximately 4,000 hours burning time per year and shall include maintenance of equipment and lamp renewals.
