<p>Plastics (except Styrofoam™) Containers, tubs and lids (ice cream, yogurt, etc.), plastic fruit, vegetable & cookie trays, bottles with the caps removed (ketchup, pop, etc.), shrink wrap, bubble wrap, plastic bags (shopping, bread, frozen food, Ziploc, etc.)</p> <p>Metal Aluminum foil, aluminum cans, aluminum pie plates & aluminum trays, tin & steel cans, and empty aerosol cans, etc. Metal lids and tops from cans and bottles (should be placed in a tin can and crimped shut).</p> <p>Glass food containers Baby food jars, Mason jars, pasta and pickle jars, etc. (remove lids and put both jar and lid in the blue bag)</p> <p>Paper cartons Dairy, juice, molasses, sauerkraut, etc.</p> <p>Refundable beverage containers Pop cans and bottles, juice packs and cans, liquor bottles, etc. (remove caps).</p> <p>Beverage containers (excluding milk containers) can also be returned to an ENVIRO-DEPOT for a refund.</p>	<p>Clean boxboard Paper towel & toilet paper rolls, cereal boxes, detergent boxes, frozen food boxes, kleenex & shoe boxes, etc.</p> <p>Low grade paper Newspapers, flyers, magazines, catalogs, file folders, greeting cards, phone books, soft & hard-covered books (remove hard covers from books and place them in the bag), junk mail and envelopes (do not remove plastic windows). Also included is egg cartons and paper trays.</p> <p>Office paper Envelopes, writing paper, shredded paper, copier paper, notepad paper, etc.</p> <p>Please keep paper in a separate bag from other recyclables.</p> <p>Corrugated cardboard (with the wavy lines between two layers) Flatten boxes and tie in 2' x 2' x 3 bundles.</p>	<p>All food waste Bones, fat, dairy products, peelings, egg shells, meat, fish, vegetable and fruit waste, seafood shells, coffee grounds, tea bags, kitchen scraps, etc.</p> <p>Soiled paper Pizza boxes, paper towels & napkins, tissues, tissue paper, wet or soiled paper & boxboard, waxed paper, cardboard, paper dishes, wooden stir sticks, etc.</p> <p>Sugar, flour & potato bags (paper). Sawdust & wood shavings.</p> <p>Yard waste Leaves, grass, twigs, etc.</p> <p>NOTE: Please do not put branches more than 2" in diameter in the green cart or branches that stick out over the top of the cart. Tie large branches in 3' long bundles and place them out for collection beside your cart. If your cart is full use compostable bags for leaves, grass, twigs, etc.</p> <p>Compostable plastic bin liners are no longer permitted, as they take too long to break down, making the processed compost unmarketable. The brown paper liners are an acceptable alternative.</p>	<p>All paper coffee cups and waxy cold drink cups. Please make sure any plastic lids are removed and recycled.</p> <p>Broken glass (wrap in newspaper and label "BROKEN GLASS"), Styrofoam™ (meat trays, cups) candy wrappers and chip bags, cigarette butts, incandescent light bulbs, clothing & footwear, wall paper, disposable diapers, personal hygiene items, vacuum cleaner bags, floor sweepings, toothpaste tubes, lint, dryer sheets, popcorn bags, soiled plastic wrap and soiled aluminum foil, textiles, frozen juice cans, pet feces & pet litter, empty paint cans (must have lid removed and be dry inside).</p> <div style="background-color: red; color: white; text-align: center; padding: 5px;">HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE</div> <p style="color: red;">Must be taken directly to the Kaizer Meadow Solid Waste Facility in a labelled container.
