

Town of Lunenburg Parking Infraction Ticket and Parking Meter Bylaw – Summary Offence Ticket Approval Update

The Nova Scotia Attorney General and Minister of Justice recently approved the Town of Lunenburg's request to amend SOT Schedule PT to the Summary Offence Ticket Regulations. This includes the Town's Parking Meter Bylaw noting the section of the Bylaw and various offences for which a Summary Offence Ticket and penalty can be issued. 

**Made under Sections 8 and 8A of Chapter 450
of the Revised Statutes of Nova Scotia, 1989,
the *Summary Proceedings Act***

I, Randy Delorey, Attorney General and Minister of Justice for the Province of Nova Scotia, pursuant to Sections 8 and 8A of Chapter 450 of the Revised Statutes of Nova Scotia, 1989, the *Summary Proceedings Act*, effective on and after the date of this order, hereby

- (a) amend the *Summary Offence Tickets Regulations*, N.S. Reg. 281/2011, made by order of the Attorney General and Minister of Justice dated October 4, 2011, to designate certain offences under the Town of Lunenburg Parking Meter By-law as parking infraction ticket offences, in the manner set forth in the attached Schedule "A"; and
- (b) order and direct that the penalty to be entered on a summons in respect of an offence set out in amendments to the schedules to the *Summary Offence Tickets Regulations*, N.S. Reg. 281/2011, as set forth in the attached Schedule "A", is the out-of-court settlement amount listed in the out-of-court settlement column set out opposite the description for the offence, and includes the charge provided for in, and in accordance with, Sections 8 and 9 of the Act.

**Amendment to the *Summary Offence Tickets Regulations*
made by the Attorney General and Minister of Justice under Sections 8 and 8A
of Chapter 450 of the Revised Statutes of Nova Scotia, 1989,
the *Summary Proceedings Act***

Schedule PT to the *Summary Offence Tickets Regulations*, N.S. Reg. 281/2011, made by order of the Attorney General and Minister of Justice dated October 4, 2011, is amended by repealing items 1-9 under the heading "Town of Lunenburg By-law No. 20 - Parking Meters" and substituting the following items:

1	Parking beyond parking space markings	7(3)	\$66.60
2	Failing to deposit coins of sufficient value in meter	11(1)	\$66.60
3	Parking over maximum period allowed by meter	11(2)	\$66.60
4	Parking commercial vehicle in parking space over 30 minutes	12(2)	\$66.60
5	Parking at meter showing time expired	14(1)	\$66.60
6	Failing to purchase time from meter	14(2)	\$66.60
7	Depositing slug	15	\$66.60
8	Parking over maximum period allowed by meter on free parking day from last week of November to December 31	18(1)	\$66.60
9	Parking over maximum period allowed by meter on additional free parking day	18(2)	\$66.60
10	Using parking space for motor vehicle, construction dumpster or contractor's equipment trailer (specify) without valid permit	19(c)(i)	\$66.60
11	Parking overnight in designated overnight parking area without valid permit	19(c)(ii)	\$66.60
12	Hindering use of parking space by placing object in parking space	20(i)	\$86.60
